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



management education to foster an eco-system that encourages risk-taking, innovation, and creativity. We aim to achieve the pinnacle of perfection and professionalism in management education.






The design of the event was spread over in three days from October 22- 24, 2021. The first session on October 22, was on the theme of Inspirational





National Accreditation National Board of Accreditation (NBA)

BIMTECH started its NBA accreditation journey in 2008. Since then all four Postgraduate programmes, namely, PGDM, PGDM (IB), PGDM (RM), and PGDM (IBM) have been accredited by the National Board of Accreditation (NBA). This year we filled for the 3rd and 2nd cycle of the Accreditation process for PGDM & PGDM IB in the month of June 2022. As a process, PRT Visit dates are also being proposed to NBA. NBA is the highest national accrediting agency under the Ministry of HRD. It is an autonomous body, with the objective of Assurance of Quality and Relevance of education, through the accreditation mechanism of programs offered by the institutions.

International Accreditation Association to Advance Collegiate Schools

of Business (AACSB)

BIMTECH started the AACSB accreditation journey in 2015. AACSB is one of the premier international accrediting agencies. AACSB's mission is to foster engagement, accelerate innovation, and amplify impact in business education. International accreditation is a rigorous and complex process; it takes 4 to 5 years to get an institute accredited. In November 2019, BIMTECH received a positive intimation from AACSB, International, advising the institute to submit the final Selfevaluation Report after they recorded BIMTECH's progress over the period. The Peer Review Team visited BIMTECH during 2020-21; the last step to get the honor of AACSB accreditation.

In recognition to its evolution as a quality institution of reckoning, the All India Council for Technical Education in India, recently granted Category 1 Graded Autonomy to BIMTECH. It recognizes the need to create an enabling environment whereby Standalone Institutions can become institutions of Global excellence. Autonomy is pivotal in promoting and Institutionalizing excellence in higher education and the regulatory framework needs to facilitate better performing institutes.

The French Foundation for Management Education (FNEGE) jointly with European Foundation of Management Development (EFMD) bestowed on BIMTECH the Business School Impact System (BSIS) Label for successful completion of the BSIS Impact process and for on-going commitment to creating and increasing the impact in June 2019. The EFMD is one of the top international accreditation bodies. BSIS is the first comprehensive impact assessment tool for business schools that helps to demonstrate their impact upon its local environment - city or region.

BIMTECH submitted the final Self Evaluation Report in the month of June 2021. The virtual Peer Review Team visit was held on July 5-7, 2022. The visit was very successful and appreciated by the AACSB PRT Team. The PRT Team has submitted its recommendation to Initial Accreditation Committee (IAC). The next meeting of IAC is expected to be held in the month of November 2022 and we eagerly await their decision.

Research Projects



Research Project granted by Ministry of Commerce

In an era of global economic challenges, diversification of trade partners and access to new markets is becoming a priority for all economies, and more so for emerging market economies like India. Of late, Latin America and the Caribbean (LAC) have emerged as important economic partners for India, despite both the economies being geographically and culturally apart. In line with enhancing trade between India and LAC, Dr. Anuj Sharma, Chairperson, International Business Program of BIMTECH has been recently awarded a research project titled "India-Latin America Trade and Logistics: Policy Suggestions for Addressing Shipping, Warehousing and Container-related Constrains" by Centre for Regional Trade (CRT), Ministry of Commerce, Government of India.

The project granted by CRT has following objectives

1. Study extant availability of shipping lines and containers, shortfalls, issues thereof and suggest ways and means of improvising the same in order to cater to seamless trade with LAC region.

2) Suggest estimated investment required in this sector for creating dedicated shipping line/ containers facility exclusively for LAC Region or in conjunction with adjacent trade region.

3) Study existing arrangements of warehousing facility that are available in India, LAC countries and issues thereof that hinder trade. Suggest ways and means of improving warehousing; extant, mode and investments required and suggest prominent places where warehousing facility would be ideally located.

The outcomes of the project are likely to enhance trade between India and LAC through policy interventions.

SUSTAINABLE TOURISM IN INDIA. SRI LANKA AND NEPAL






Centers of Excellence in sustainable tourism to boost economic development and enhance university-business cooperation in Southern Area/CESTour.

Objective: The project aims to build the concept of Sustainable Tourism in India, Nepal, and Sri Lanka with a view to enhanced industry-academia collaboration & robust infrastructural and scholastic support to the industry.

Duration of the Project: January 2021 to January 2023

Progress: After analyzing the current status of the tourism industry, the project has developed a "Status Quo Report - Sustainable Tourism in India" with the

collective effort of three project teams from the BIRLA Institute of Management Technology (BIMTECH), Institute of Public Enterprise (IPE), and NIRMA University, India. The report unveils the opportunities, challenges, issues, and best practices in sustainable tourism initiatives and implementations in India. Overall, the report provides an inclusive insight into the status quo of sustainable tourism context, development priorities, issues, challenges, and opportunities in India to guide the implementation of the CESTour project. As convener of the Work Package –I, team BIMTECH has already produced 3 Status Quo National Report, 1 Comparative report, 1 focus group report, and



1 Good Practice report which aims to provide a range of good practice examples focusing on sustainable tourism efforts and strategies on the example of specific cases in Austria, Germany, and Italy.



Resurgent India: The Economics of Atmanirbhar Bharat

The Economics of Atmanirbhar Bharat

In the backdrop of the Corona virus having wreaked havoc on nations across the world and adversely impacting economic growth of countries, the government and monetary authorities, such as the Reserve Bank of India, stepped forward with conventional as well as unconventional stimulus measures. This was the time for the Government and fellow Indians to reboot, redraw, and reinvent the wheel of progress, and paint a new standing in the World Economic Order. Thus, in light of the above-mentioned macroeconomic scenario existing in India in June 2020, the authors decided to continuously examine the important measures and policies announced by the Government and evaluate its impact on the country.

Part 1 of the book traces the preceding trends in the economic growth of the country during 2010-20, the initial impact of the virus on the Indian economy, the macroeconomic perspectives, including the required fiscal measures through the very first post-pandemic budget, i.e., for 2021-22, and the country's progress on the path to economic recovery in the first quarter of 2022.

Part 2 critically analyses policy initiatives undertaken by the Government for achieving an Atmanirbhar Bharat (self-reliant India), short-term and long-term structural reforms, agricultural reforms, the six pillars on which the union budget 2021-22 has been formulated, and bold measures like the proposal for asset monetization of PSUs and government's re-think on retrospective taxes.

Part 3 lays out a roadmap of policy suggestions which warrant government focus and attention to make India into a self-reliant nation. These initiatives can help in achieving the dream of doubling farmers' income and making India into a global manufacturing hub. This section also discusses the importance of cooperative federalism and challenges before the government in making India into a self-reliant nation, especially in terms of administrative machinery and the judicial system.

The year 2021, marks 100 years of the Case Method, the use of which started in Harvard Business School, in 1921, to inculcate critical thinking, problem solving and decision making in the Management Students. The new generation is oblivious to the limitations of the past. The recent pandemic has made us realise that the future is unprecedented, and that we have to constantly be prepared for the unknown. However, the traditional ways of writing and teaching cases may not suffice anymore. 




South Asian Journal of Business Management Cases (SAJBMC)

Since late 2020 we had announced that SAJBMC will entirely shift from teaching cases to qualitative case study research. This strategic decision was taken keeping in mind the need to increase citation which can be achieved by publishing articles which have theoretical contributions. To announce these changes and help in creating awareness about QCSR the team has been using the editorial of the Journal.

With these strategic changes, the quality of cases in SAJBMC has increased to the extent that it got listed in ABS journal quality. Additionally, the downloads have reaching to 79000 by the end of 2021 as compared to 27702 by the end of 2020.





Conference Books ICMC

Out of the presented cases in 11th ICMC 2021, 48 cases were published in two books by Bloomsbury Publishers. One of the books was titled Case Studies on Perspectives on Entrepreneurship and Sustainability included 26 cases by 73 authors. The second book is titled Case Studies on Perspectives on Management and Digital Business included 22 cases by 49 authors.

On the December 3, 2021, BIMTECH, Birla Institute of Management Technology, Greater Noida (NCR), India, in collaboration with the University of Eastern Finland and University of South Florida, inaugurated the International Conference of Management Cases (ICMC). This was the eleventh year that ICMC has been organized at BIMTECH. As it was an unprecedented period, this year the conference was conducted in

online mode, on the Zoom platform. Hence, instead of the usual two days, the conference was scheduled for three days, keeping in mind the different time zones of the presenters.

ICMC invites stimulating original, unpublished, research/teaching cases, based on primary and/or secondary data, field studies. Each teaching case must show strong linkage to a theory, concept, framework, or model while a research case should show theoretical considerations. ICMC aims at international relevance and encourages authors from all over the world to participate and share their experiences on a platform created for academicians, practitioners, consultants, research scholars, and students of management studies.

This year, 52 cases collectively written by about 170 authors were presented over two days (December 4-5, 2021) in 11 concurrent technical sessions. Each technical session was chaired by two reputed case writers who gave

constructive feedback to the presenters' cases. The conference was attended by 35 delegates from 9 countries. The largest contingent of 9 delegates participated from Finland. Overall more than 100 delegates attended the three-day virtual conference.

The first day of the conference witnessed enthusiastic participation from all the delegates representing different parts of the world. The event started by greeting the Keynote speakers, Prof. Rauno Sairinen, Professor of Environment Policy, University of Finland. In his Keynote speech. He talked about "Paradoxes in sustainable and green business: How 'dirty' mining industry is developing itself as climate saver and responsible actor?" He spoke on a very relevant topic and the deliberation would give many directions for case research to solve local problems.

Of the cases presented 11 were selected in the Forum for collective wisdom. This is a unique technical session for the cases that were ranked as either good or excellent by the reviewers. This session enriches the discussion and is in a round table format and feedback is captured in advance of other presenters in the same session. Due to its unique features it benefits the authors, and hence, is highly appreciated by the delegates.



3rd Case Master Development Workshop

A week after the 11th ICMC 2021, CMCD organized the 3rd Case Master Development Workshop on the December 11, 2021, with Prof. Rauno Sairinen, Professor of Environment Policy, as a resource person. The topic was "Developing case studies on social responsibility of resources industries." The session was well supported by Hanna Lektimaki, Professor Innovation Management, and Ville-Veikko Pispanen, Project Researcher. All the three resource persons were from the University of Eastern Finland.

The key take aways from the workshop were:

- Social impact research and CSR case analysis in resource industries
- Discussion on conceptual and methodological developments of social responsibility and sustainability issues. The 90 mins workshop was attended by around 25 participants that include both national and international ICMC delegates and BIMTECH faculty. Given the need to create a sustainable world while ensuring business continuity of the resources industries, participants found the workshop to be very relevant.

Ever since 2012, to develop analytical and decision-making skills in students, **BIMTECH Centre for Management Case** Development (CMCD) has been organizing the Case Competition. However, with the increasing complexity of business and the needs to create more sustainable future the future leaders also need to hone their research acumen. Hence, in 2021, CMCD decided to have a Summer Internship Project Competition for the second year students to showcase their research capabilities. SIP was chosen as an input since it is case based and hence falls under arena of case method. For the first year students we kept the traditional format of the case competition wherein they were asked to analyse a teaching case which was on Sustainability issue. The competitions were conducted virtually and included judges from the institutions outside BIMTECH. We got a wonderful response from

across the country. Total of 331 teams from 1st year and 71 teams from the second year registered and participated actively. Attractive cash prizes of 10000/- and 8000/- rupees along with the certificate of merit were given to the teams scoring first and second positions in the competition.

Introducing Case Method Forum for Management

The Vision for SAJBMC was revised in late 2020 as 'Empowering Management Faculty with Case Method'. This was because qualitative research done with case approach has potential of either building or extending a theory, use of this method may increase the contribution of the research output. To realise above vision in 2021 we started Case Method Forum for Management (CMFM) to conduct online workshops for QCSR and Case Workshops to connect with B Schools. Purpose was to help faculty understand the structure of the QCSR so that at some point of time they can write cases for SAJBMC. From July 2021 we conducted series of five QCSR workshops and 14 teaching and research case workshops. Over 350 faculty attended so far. We are planning to conduct a series of inperson workshops for QCSR. First one will be on Sept 17,2022.

Centre for Faculty Development

Enhancing Intellectual Capital



The Centre for Faculty Development identified four areas for development:

a) Domain knowledge/Area of Interest (industry relevance)
b) Research
c) Leadership & Institutional Building
d) Faculty Wellbeing

Significant progress was made on most of these aspects during the year. Almost all faculty members and research scholars attended at least one development programme during the year. There were three in-house programmes, one of which was attended by almost all faculty members and 14 external programmes which were attended by 42 faculty members and research scholars.

The year started with a 3 day internal programme titled **"Future Roadmap** of Management Education". This was attended by 60 faculty members from BIMTECH and 25 external faculty members. The program spanned 14 sessions figuring 9 special Lectures by the 'Who's Who' of Indian Management education and 5 panel discussions among BIMTECH faculty. Beginning with context laying through a panel discussion on the Future of the MBA, the various sessions explored the challenges that have been generated in terms of the requirement for new teaching methods, balancing teaching and research and other activities, and moving out of silos and into a multidisciplinary work culture to provide a more holistic learning approach. Several lectures also expanded on the role of faculty in institution building. Special lectures were delivered by:

Another notable internal programme that was conducted was the "Year End Kaleidoscopic Reflections" a three day FDP from May 4 - 6 2022. The thought was to have a program that would encourage faculty to benefit from contemporary books by highly credible authors from a very diverse range of disciplines in Business & Society such as Learning, Economic Potential, Artificial Intelligence, Branding and Neuroscience, Work from Anywhere, Sustainability, Communications, Selfdevelopment, and The Digital Future. The FDP was co-created by the Director of BIMTECH, Dr. H. Chaturvedi, along with a host of faculty members and The Centre for Faculty Development. About 50 Faculty Members and Research Scholars participated on each of the 3 days. The overall response was overwhelmingly positive with a request to make this a regular activity at BIMTECH in the years to come.

Several presenters conducted engaging team activities and exercises in the context of the book that they presented. Dr. Bhimaraya Metri, Director IIM Nagpur was the Chief Guest and set the context for the program with his inaugural address. The concluding session was a discussion on the book "Brands and the Brain: How to Use Neuroscience to Create Impactful Brands". The author, Dr. Arvind Sahay, Professor, IIM Ahmedabad graced the session to discuss his book.

Another significant initiative was the 6-month programme on Research Methods that was conducted by Dr. Sunil Mithas, World Class Scholar & Professor, MUMA College of Business, Tampa, FL, USA. The rigorous, intensive, and demanding programme enabled participating faculty and research scholars significant enhance their research skills. The programme had participants from BIMTECH as well as from external institutions.









Centre for Business 4.0

The Centre for Business 4.0 was established in November 2020 to actualise the intent of the BIMTECH Strategic Plan (2020-21 to 2024-25) wherein the enabling strategy 1 is "To orient students, faculty, and staff to become value-conscious human beings ready to face Industry 4.0 and capable of producing value for all stakeholders".

The Centre initiated its activities in the year 2021-22.

The immediate focus was to design, develop and deliver a core course titled "Innovating for Business 4.0" in the PGDM programme to begin with. The course has been designed & developed with inputs from globally renowned stalwarts such as Vivek Wadhwa, Distinguished Fellow & Senior Professor, Carnegie Mellon University (Silicon Valley Campus), CA, USA and Ismail Amla, Chief Growth Officer, Capita, London, U.K. amongst others and is scheduled for delivery from September 2022. With this the centre has developed the capability for offering this core course in all 4 sections of the PGDM programme.

The second key activity was to recruit appropriate faculty for teaching & research associated with the intent of the Centre. A full time faculty member was recruited who joined the Centre. Four research publications in leading journals including A category such as "Journal of Cleaner Production and "IEEE Transactions" have already been accepted for publication.

The third key activity that was initiated was to map existing courses that were being delivered/proposed to be delivered in various programmes at BIMTECH. Over 40 such courses including core courses, and courses in vertical specialisations and bouquet courses were identified.

Finally the centre has initiated work on designing and developing a faculty development programme and an executive development programme on Business 4.0.



Centre for Online Studies (COOLS)

The Center for Online Studies (COOLS) was established on the July 1, 2020 with the vision of providing a flexible, reasonable, and rigorous learning model. Cohort 2 started on September 1, 2021 with a total of 206 learners (68 % male, 32 % female learners). Learners were from three different countries i.e. India, Zealand, and Bangladesh. Similarly, cohort 3 started on February 2, 2022 with a total of learners 139 (73% male learners, 27 % female learners). In this cohort, learners were admitted from India and the United States of America. We are now taking admission for our fourth Cohort.

Mind Your Business

November 29, 2021, "Entrepreneurship is more than just doing business; it is a way of life, from learning to negotiate to handling finances, from dealing with crises to improving critical thinking." The event was designed to provide participants with a variety of experiences that will help them grow as managers. Round 2: Negotiation: Each team was given a case/scenario containing a situation relating to real-world problems that one might face in their professional/business life. To illustrate, a company is set to launch an IPO and suddenly a few days before, a media report that tarnished the image of the company and shaked the shareholder confidence in the management. The team members brain stormed among themselves. Two teams competed in a role play, with one team representing the company's CEO handling last-minute crises with information leaks and the other team representing media reporters, and they negotiated and came up with the best solution for the given situation. The team with the better approach and better arguments to back up their case won the round.

Round 3: Case Crunch: The qualified teams were asked to submit a detailed presentation explaining their case strategy in round 2. Also, to extend the case further, they were to submit a presentation to represent both side team 1 and team 2 of their respective case. Best interpretation of the case makes them win.

As a result, more than 50 teams with two or three team members competed in the challenge, which was narrowed down to eight teams in the second round to crunch the case. In the final, the two teams with the best strategy won. Dr. Abhijit K Chattoraj, Dr. Abha Rishi (BIMTECH), Dr. Shalini Sharma (BIMTECH), Mr. Anil Singh (AIC BIMTECH), and Mr. Sanyam Dhingra (AIC BIMTECH) were panelists who monitored and scored the final two teams. Team Analysis Aces, led by Ms. Ankita Loomba, Charvi Gosain, and Devika Marwah, won the game, with Team Amigos 2.0, led by Mr. Abhisarth Gupta, Mr. Dhananjay Anil, and Ms. Akshita Agarwal, finishing second.


ENTREPRENEURIAL

The Admission 2022 efforts started with the online application form going live on Sept 23rd 2021.BIMTECH Admission efforts for 2022 however, saw an almost 4 percent increase in number of applicants vying for admissions to the various courses on offer.

It was a great and enriching journey where we successfully replicated the previous initiatives - such as early round of PI process, use of digital/social media for student engagement, student/alumni referral scheme and flexible online PI process. Through these efforts, the applicants to seat ratio is being maintained at a healthy 1:10. Despite of the COVID 19 global pandemic, there is a significant improvement in the final turnout percentage of candidates appearing in the PI selection process.

Apart from these, we successfully introduced online payment process for remitting 1st instalment of hostel & mess fee this year. Online payment process of remitting tuition fee was successfully introduced last

year. Automated/ digitized admission process along with online payment process made the entire process error free and paperless which added complete transparency and operational convenience.


The good number of applications and the pool thereof resulted in the selection of a good number of quality candidates ensuring "houseful" status for PGDM & PGDM-IB programs.

Commerce stream dominated the admissions cycle this year also by contributing 36% in the total intake. Students with management background are the second biggest contributor with 22% intake while other streams contributed with 42% in the total intake.

Moreover, there is subtle improvement in gender diversity, with 200 (147 last year) female students joining across all courses - making the ratio of male: female to 59:41, which was61:39 last year. Our continued effort of bringing students from other countries has paid dividend. This year we could attract prospective students from Nepal. Our dependency on north region was63%.While an increase was noticed in students coming from eastern and central region this year.




The number of students with first division throughout their academic records & work experience was 71% and 16% respectively.



Intellectual **Deliberations**

UNION BUDGET 2022 DELIBERATION BY Mr. SOUMYA KANTI GHOSH

Birla Institute of Management Technology (BIMTECH) and Eco chamber club organized a deliberation on "THE UNION BUDGET 2022-23" on February 5, 2022. Dr. Soumya Kanti Ghosh, Group Chief Economic Advisor, State Bank of India, was the keynote speaker. Dr. Ghosh is currently Group Chief Economic Advisor, State Bank of India. He is also a member of the SEBI Advisory Committee on Research, Economic Advisory Council, CII, and Editorial Advisory Board of the Indian Institute of Banking and Finance. He also serves as a member of the Indian Banks' Association's Monetary Policy Group. He provides inputs to the Reserve Bank of India's Expert Committee to Revise and Strengthen the Monetary Policy Framework.

Dr. Ghosh started his deliberation by delving on the focus area of this year's budget and how the finance minister unveiled a bigger budget of rupees 39.45 lakh crore with a massive push on infrastructure spending. From the expansion of national highways to the introduction of the digital rupee, to taxing crypto currencies and digital assets, to affordable housing, the government aims to fire up the economy's key engines to sustain a faster recovery from the pandemic. He also threw light on the pillars of the Union Budget 2022, namely: PM Gati Shakti, Inclusive Development, Productivity Enhancement & Investment, Sunrise Opportunities, Energy Transition, and Climate Action and the Financing of Investments.

GUEST LECTURE BY MR. DAVINDER MALHOTRA: DERIVATIVES AND RISK MANAGEMENT

Dr. Davinder Malhotra is a Professor of Finance at Thomas Jefferson University, Philadelphia. He has been associated with BIMTECH for the past many years and this year too, students from the PGDM 2020-22 batch had the privilege to attend his lectures and gain knowledge on Derivatives and Risk Management. He has an overall academic experience of more than 27 years. He is also the Editor-in-Chief of the Afro-Asian Journal of Finance and Accounting (AAJFA), which aims at fostering discussions and research for the development of the finance and accounting disciplines in these regions. Dr. Malhotra is also the member of Editorial Board for various journals like International Journal of Bonds and Derivatives,

Finance India, and Indian Journal of Business and Economics; just to name a few. Apart from this, he holds an administrative experience of about 9 years as the Director of MBA program. The students gained a lot of insight into the topic and interacting with such a distinguished professor proved to be a very valuable experience. BIMTECH has consistently tried to invite esteemed professionals to impart knowledge to the students and in spite of the restrictions due to the pandemic, was able to organize sessions online with international faculty.

The students of PGDM 2020-22 had yet another golden opportunity to interact with Mr. Yogesh Bellani, the CEO & Whole Time Director of Field Fresh Foods Pvt Ltd, since 2013. He has leadership experience of over 24 years in the food Industry and has a proven track record of setting up businesses from its conception. Under his vision & leadership, Del Monte has emerged as one of the fastest growing food & beverage brand, built a robust exports business and grew its B2B business to become one of the most distributed brands in food service, winning several awards and recognitions.

He is passionate about teaching and learning and is also a guest lecturer at some of India's leading business schools and serves on the Advisory Council of Birla Institute of Management Technology, Academic Council of Jaipuria Institute of Management and on the Advisory Academic Board of the Strategy, Innovation and Entrepreneurship Area of IMT Ghaziabad. He is very passionate about coaching and he serves on the Advisory Board of the Atal Incubation Centre at Birla Institute of Management.

He shared his valuable knowledge on the topic "Global Brand Management" today with students of international marketing. He focused on telling the students how the journey of branding happens in the real world. This insightful session helped the students understand branding, the relevance of a brand and strategies that they can apply in the corporate for branding.





GUEST LECTURE BY MR. MADAN SABNAVIS: IMPACT OF COVID19 ON INDIAN ECONOMY: CHALLENGES AND OPPORTUNITIES

The Eco chamber of BIMTECH organized a talk with Mr. Madan Sabnavis, Chief Economist, CARE Ratings, on the "Impact of Covid19 on Indian Economy: Challenges and Opportunities" on Wednesday, the August 25, 2021. The highly engaging session gave a comprehensive view of the growth and recovery of the Indian economy in the aftermath of the Covid19 pandemic.

Mr. Sabnavis indicated that even in the time before the pandemic, the economy was showing less growth. He mentioned that in order to fully recover, there should be more employment opportunities and the poor should become less poor. The media are projecting optimistic scenarios showing high numbers for growth of the economy but Mr. Sabnavis advises us to take these numbers with caution due to reasons like the base effect. He then went on to talk about the engines of growth of the economy - consumption, investment, Government and trade. In conclusion, the numbers projected by the media might not be totally believable but India has a lot of potential for growth. Mr. Sabnavis adds that the next year might also be a year of recovery. BFSI, IT, FMCG and healthcare might be the industries to watch since they will continue to grow.

PROJECT MANAGEMENT FOR OPERATIONS

A session on Project Management was conducted on August 28, 2021 for PGDM Operations batch 2022 by Business Management Programme department. The guest for the session was Dr. Sarvesh Swarup, the Former Deputy Director General Ministry of Commerce & Industry Govt. of India. With over 35 years of techno-economic experience in high-ranking positions in the Indian government, as well as affiliations with various key economic bodies, medium to big corporations, and management institutes, Dr. Swarup explained how to use knowledge, skills, tools and techniques to manage different projects in an eminent way.

Dr. Swarup began to explain about various elements in the project management which were man, material, machine,

finance and technology. Then a short description was given on the basic principles of project management such as Sequencing, Purchasing, Total Quality Management, Inventory Management, Planning, Logistics, Warehousing, Material Handling, Transportation Management and Process Improvement Techniques. The whole discussion and question and answer session were very engaging and insightful in project management perspective.

GUEST LECTURE BY MR. BHUSHAN SETH: DIGITAL INSURANCE

The session was conducted by Mr. Bhushan Seth (Chief Risk Officer at Zopper) an insurtech strategy enthusiast. The session started with a small introduction of Mr. Bhushan who is proficient at-Risk Management, Program design, Strategic alliances and Product design. He is an AllI as well as MBA and MS in Insurance from Institute of Chartered Financial Analysts of India. His previous engagements include JB BODA Insurance brokers and Pioneer Insurance brokers. He also founded insurtech start-up apnipolicy.com. Mr.Bhushan discussed digital insurance where he started with the history of insurance sales and insurance agencies and then gradually turned onto the new channels emerging like Banca, Digital, Broking and Partners. He addressed some of the challenges faced during this digital journey for e.gThe women in rural areas are not so comfortable in giving out information or clicking pictures then this way the digital journey becomes very difficult. The session ended with how distribution is the king with 33% focus and he discussed the Ola case study to tell us more about the MMT model and IRCTC model. The session was very interactive and engaging. The students got an idea about insurance and the various aspects of it.

SPECIAL SESSION ON MARKET RESEARCH

On September 2, 2021 a session on Market Research was organized for the students of Birla Institute of Management and technology. The Session was conducted by Mr. Rajesh Kurup who is the executive director of Kantar Millward Brown. Mr. Rajesh Kurup beautifully explained that "No Research is better than Bad Research", he said that there are some marketing issues that are not researchable, not ethical and also not worthy of the time and cost as a researcher has to put in it and thus no research is better than doing bad research. Market. He ended his session by saying that Marketing as a concept is evolving because it is related to other fields of study which helps it to be flexible and adaptive and also it is very important to stay relevant as the world is changing every moment.

INTELLECTUAL DELIBERATIONS

GUEST LECTURE BY MR. ALOK GUPTA : CYBERSECURITY

BIMTECH had organized a guest lecture on Cyber security as a part of the ISMB course for 1st trimester PGDM students on September 25, 2021. The highly enlightening session was taken by Mr. Alok Gupta, Founder & CEO, Pyramid Cyber Security & Forensic & President of Alumni association of BIMTECH. The session included an introduction to cyber security, Covid-19 and its impact on cyber security and future prospects of this domain.

Mr. Alok Gupta stressed the growing importance of cyber security especially in today's digital world of cloud servers and IoT devices. Prediction, prevention, detection, resolution and protection from cyber-attacks, breaches and threats are some of the essentials of cyber security.

Mr. Alok Gupta gave us insights about malware, phishing and the most dangerous hacker groups. He also talked about IT and security audit and assessment and vulnerability assessments penetration tests. We were also introduced to the concepts of red teaming, multi factor authentication, 24x7 monitoring and threat intelligence. He also warned us against opening or clicking on any unknown links and how to protect against these cyber-attacks. We were cautioned against disclosing any sensitive information like passwords over the internet.

CXO TALK BYMR. PIYUSH CHOWHAN, GROUP CHIEF INFORMATION OFFICER, LULU **INTERNATIONAL, ABU DHABI**

The CXO Talk conducted on November 20, 2021 by Piyush Chowhan on the topic 'Disrupt or Die in the Digital era' was very interesting and relevant for today's scenario. He started his session by talking about how big companies like Toshiba and GE are splitting because they are not data driven and are very behind technology wise. He emphasizes on the fact that in today's scenario to stay relevant and to stay in the business we need to create value through technology like Tesla is doing. Covid taught us the importance of technology and how it is the way forward but it is not easy to convert towards digital technology and only 3% have been able to convert their company digitally. Piyush Chowha n mentions that time is very important in digital transformation and Covid has fastened the speed for this. He also talks about innovation and says that we need to be agile and need to have a digital mindset.

GUEST LECTURE BY AMIT SINHA, IDFC FISRT BANK

Banking, Financial services and Insurance Sector is one of the most imperative verticals for our us as PGDM students. In order to enlighten the students more about the same and enrich them with the knowledge associated to it, we the students of PGDM, 1st year were introduced to Mr. Amit Sinha, country Head, IDFC First Bank.

He explained to us the sensitivities in the BFSI sector and how dominant this sector has become. He further put in the rosy picture of how digitalization has reduced the gap between consumers and banks and how everything is now at a touch. Mr. Sinha became a ray of hope for the students when he busted the myths about Job cuts due to technology and the arduous working environment in the BFSI sector. 


The invited members offered valuable advice and suggestions in both these respects. Internal Area meetings were held following this so as to deliberate on the suggestions and decide on implementation.



Need Assessment of Community in Villages of Himachal Pradesh

Villages of Himachal Pradesh BIMTECH's team conducted "Situation Analysis and Need Assessment "of villages near to Kutehr in Chamba district of Himachal Pradesh. In spite of very difficult terrain and villages situated at very high altitude and scattered, the team successfully completed the survey and assessment. The final report of the study submitted to JSW was submitted in August 2021. This assessment helped management of JSW Energy Ltd. to design proper CSR interventions to meet the needs of communities who are residing near to their plant operations.

Collaboration with Sphere India

BIMTECH and Sphere India, a National Coalition of humanitarian, resilience and development organizations in India joined hand to facilitate better partnerships between CSOs, Private Sector (CSR Foundations) Government, and other actors, primarily whole of society approach emphasized by the Hon'ble Prime Minister in his 10-point agenda for disaster risk reduction (DRR) in Development. Had a series of consultations including interviews with 50 CSRs heads to understand their challenges and suggestions for the way forward. A draft of it as partnership standards is ready and had national level consultations in Delhi and regional level consultations in Guwahati, Mumbai, and Bengaluru in partnership with the Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs(IICA) under the aegis of the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India.

Study will help the Epsilon to identify the needs of the communities & also help in identifying the CSR projects for their holistic development.

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
