

PROFESSOR GANESHI LAL: THE PEOPLE'S GOVERNOR




"DON'T IMITATE, BE YOURSELF"

rof. Ganeshi Lal was appointed as the Hon'ble Governor of Odisha on 29th May 2018, by the Hon'ble President Ram Nath Kovind. He was administered the oath of office by Hon'ble Chief Justice of High Court of Odisha Shri Justice Vineet Saran in a function held at the Abhishek Hall of Raj Bhavan.

Prof. Lal was born in Sirsa, Haryana on first March 1942 and is married to Smt. Sushila Devi. He is an Academician Par Excellence, and holds degree in English Honors. He further proceeded to acquire a post- graduate education in Mathematics. He has been splendid in studies and stood First Class in FA. BA. and MA Class, in addition is a Gold Medallist. Afterwards, he assisted as a professor in various government colleges of Haryana between 1964 and 1991.

Starting around 1962, Prof. Lal effectively took the plunge into the political stream by joining the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh and held posts in the Hisar, Rohtak Wing of RSS. Prof. Lal's political profession began with grassroots associations of the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP). He was former State President of Haryana BJP, a prior Chairman of Akhil Bharatiya Vidyarthi Parishad, Haryana, and a previous National President of the BJP Disciplinary Committee. During the Emergency period in the country in 1976, Prof. Lal was sent to prison. He additionally vigorously contributed in the Ram Janmabhoomi Movement, Prof. Lal was chosen as MLA from Sirsa electorate in 1996, and became a Minister in the Haryana Vikas Party - BJP Government in Haryana from 1996-99.

He has been awarded with Mathematics Genius Awardee

Yash Mishra at Raj Bhavan.

Prof. Lal has visited Odisha twice before taking over as a governer, but had immense vision for the state. He believed, "Odisha is a land of beauty, love and peace. Sensitivity and smile of its people are Odisha's ornaments. The spirit of Odisha is one that never gets defeated. Even if a Chandashok defeats it the battleground, the state has the power to transform him to Dharmashok. The same spirit continues even today. It is holistic and inclusive."

His primary focus has been on making universities of Odisha competitive and retutative, to attract and provide high quality education to scholars from all over the country. Under his leadership, currently Odisha has a total 30 universities in the State including Central University and Deemed to be University. The process of selection of Vice Chancellor practised in Odisha has drawn appreciation and recognition from Ministry of HRD.

He recommended for setting up of a common recruitment cell by State Government to fill up vacant teaching and non-teaching posts in universities to make it transparent and to efficient as repetitive process at each University delays the recruitment process.

He believes, "Our education system should be designed and revitalised as such where we can produce people who are imbued with a spirit of inquiry and remain open to new ideas and at the same time holding high our own culture and ethos. We need to foster a new mindset and adopt an analytical stance".

Prof. Lal have faith in the power of investment in sports, and believes sit will be an investment in youth, and



investment in youth is an investment in future. In addition to this, he projected Odisha's potential internationally by transforming Bhubaneswar, the Capital City of Odisha into the 'Sports Capital' of India following successful hosting of a number of national and international sports events like FIH (International Hockey Federation) Men's World Cup Hockey, Olympic Qualifying event in Hockey, Asian Athletics Championship to cite a few.

Bhubaneswar becomes the first city to receive the provisional clearance to host the prestigious FIFA (International Federation of Association Football) Women's Under-17 World Cup. It will be the first global football tournament for women in the country and a big honour for the State. Similarly, the Capital Region Urban Transport, Bhubaneswar has been conferred with the award of Commendable Initiative in the category of Best Bus Service Project by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs very recently, Prof. Lal says proudly in his speech at the 50th Conference of Governors at Rashtrapati Bhavan, New Delhi.

Prof. Lal has an astounding vision for the state of Odisha for which he has been working religiously and with full dedication. Odisha will undoubtedly be more extravagant and gainer from the Hon'ble Prime Minister's vision, focus, and persistent endeavours for the advancement of Odisha. He has shown exceptional interest in Odisha as he devoted various projects to the country and established a framework for a few new activities. The Multi-Modal Logistics Park (MMLP) at Jharsuguda will make Jharsuguda the great center point of logistics in the locale.

Garjanbahal coal mineshafts and Jharsuguda-Baraipali-Subdega rail connection will further develop the coal transport.

Jharsuguda air terminal is the second completely operational air terminal in the State. Additionally, 4.5 MT development of Rourkela Steel Plant, or on the other hand initiation of work for the restoration of Talcher Fertilizer Plant with most recent innovation will provide employment to a large number of people. These activities in areas of connectivity, education, and growth will significantly help individuals of Odisha and prepare for the well-being of the future generations and the State overall.

His views on women are thought-provoking and motivating. In his inspiring speech on International Women's Day, at the NALCO Research & Training Centre (NRTC) in Bhubaneswar, the Hon'ble Governor quoted movingly from Ramcharitmanas and the Vedas, where women have been put in the highest pedestal. Prof. Ganeshi Lal, was all praise for women who are working tirelessly in various fields and lauded women for making a difference and contributing to the growth of the Nation. He said, "Our women employees have always played a significant role in strengthening the Company. They have always delivered and excelled at their work& beyond. We are proud of their achievements and consistent contributions round the year."

Prof. Lal, a brilliant academician in his heydays, heaped the praise on KISS which now houses over 27,000 children, meeting all their expenses and educating them from KG to PG. "KISS is a flyover from India to Bharat. It's loving those who were never loved, respecting those who were never respected, reaching the unreached and funding the unfunded", he remarked.

"Before two to three years back, 10000 scientists in a 27 km long tunnel under 300 feet of the earth spent Rs 50,000 crore, we're searching for God Particles. If they were to come to this place, there was no need for searching for the God Particles", he added.

He motivates his people by saying, "You are not thought, you are beyond intelligence". Think big, do big. He addresses today's youth by saying, "Do not focus on copying other's work, you have a blank paper, an intelligent mind, right on your own; if you want to achieve something".

Strong willpower, determination, and hard work will bring success to anybody, and more laurels to the state and the

INVEST INDIA, THE NATIONAL INVESTMENT PROMOTION AGENCY, IS BORN FROM A VISION TO PRESENT INDIA'S UNTAPPED POTENTIAL TO A GLOBAL AUDIENCE OF INVESTORS AND BUSINESSES. FORMED IN 2009, IT WAS NOT UNTIL 2015 WHEN, UNDER THE LEADERSHIP OF PRIME MINISTER NARENDRA MODI, THE GOVERNMENT'S 'OWN STARTUP' WAS ABLE TO TAKE WINGS.

eepak Bagla, Managing Director, Chief Executive Officer, Invest India began his professional journey with the World Bank in Washington DC. In 1989 he joined Citibank Global Corporate and Investment Banking group and held a few obligations across Europe, Africa, Asia, and Australia. In 2007 he joined Private Equity to begin an India devoted asset for the center framework.

He is also a member of the Ministry of Finance directing Committee on Fintech and a Member of the High-Level board of the Atal Innovation Mission accountable for laying out and increasing incubators and tinkering labs across India. Mr. Bagla was on the Investment Committee for the Government US \$ 1.5 billion "Fund of Funds for Start-ups" laid out under the Prime Minister's Startup India activity plan. He is likewise on the Advisory Board of the Government \$7 billion "Fund of Funds for MSMEs". He is the President of the Geneva-based World Association of Investment Promotion Agencies with the participation of 105 nations. He is a unique invitee of the Prime Minister's Science Technology and Innovation Advisory Council too. He was an extraordinary invitee to the Government of India's, "Significant Level Committee on Financing Infrastructure" - (2011-2013), a member from the Banking and Finance Committee of the Bureau of Indian Standards (ISO subsidiary 2005-06), and a member of the council laid out by the Government to suggest corporate administration standards for autonomous directors (2006). He was elected President of the Delhi Management Association (2008-09).

Mr. Bagla has a four-year certification with Honors in Economics from St Stephens College, New Delhi, and a double Masters in International Diplomacy and International Trade and Finance from The School of Foreign Service, Georgetown University, Washington DC. Mr. Bagla has been presented "Grande Ufficiale dell Ordine Della Stella d'Italia" by the President of the Republic of Italy.

With over 30 years of involvement with multilateral and banking, Bagla brings exceptional outlooks from the corporate world along with a capacity to align them to government vision. Under his authority, Invest India has become stronger in strength, being evaluated as an 'Incredible Place to Work' two times. Amazingly, the ethos that Invest India presents to likely investors additionally personifies.

26/11 CHANGED HIS LIFE

On the morning of 26/11, Mr. Bagla had checked into the Oberoi, Running 7 minutes late for the supper, which he booked with his partner Michael Queen at Kandahar café for 9 pm, his table had been dispensed to another person. At around 9.40 pm, being halfway through their supper, Michael suspected the noises he heard to be gunshots. Shortly, there was a boisterous blast, and the glass entryway of the Kandahar crashed and two men with backpacks entered and began shooting. The first individuals they shot at were on the table Mr, Bagla booked initially. They ran into the kitchen and afterward through it, discussed to not hide but instead continued to run till they arrived staircase and approached their room on the 12th floor. Michael's room was on another floor. They stayed in their rooms for 2 days. Not long after dawn, they saw an NSG sniper from the window. They consoled each other through gestures. At 2.30 pm on November 28, someone knocked their door- and there they were, the NSG men.

HOW DID HE COME UP WITH INVEST INDIA?

After this incident, his life completely changed and he was looking forward to working in an NGO. Alongside government was looking to set up an investment promotion agency for India. In India there are one of the highest complexities of doing business, even then had no Investment promotion agency at that time. This is where prime minister Modi came up and said I want to set up one. That's when Deepak Bagla connected with prime minister Modi and was offered an opportunity to work with setting up of investment promotion agency for India, and he gladly accepted.

Later the NDA government launched its Make in India program, the Center chose a small team that used to work from the workplace of the Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FICCI) and transformed it into a not-for-profit company, Invest India Ltd. Government trusted Mr. Bagla with this responsibility. At Invest India, Bagla was given a free hand to outline functional standards and to hire people.

SUCCESS STORY OF INVEST INDIA

Bagla, while guaranteeing equality of opportunity, proudly runs a team of over 300 committed experts whose average age is 30, one that can pull diverse elements of what makes India unique and pitch investors quality opportunities. This is truly reflective of India, a country whose median age is 28.4 years and whose youth exemplifies innovation and excellence. This is perhaps most evident in Invest India's recognition as the World's Most Innovative Investment Promotion Agency 2021 by OCO Global, with a budget of 1/10th of the competitors. His team is responsible for 4 verticals. One is investment promotion and facilitation, where there is a point of contact for any investor both domestic and globally to help them every day, to show them the market opportunity, to get them more approvals, to get the land and partner. It's a mix of an investment bank

with a high-end consulting firm.

The second part is that he is the execution arm for Start-up India. The prime minister launched start-up India in January 2016 execution. Within 50 months, India Today is number 3 in the world number unicorns, number 2 in the world number of start-ups, and number one for new start-up adding every day, and over 70 percent of business requests are coming from smaller towns, so the growth of new India is going to be propelled bottom-up.

The third is the AGNII, accelerated growth of new India innovation, this is where The Prime Minister's Science, Technology and Innovation Advisory Council (PM-STIAC) Innovations happening in India are studied and fast-track onto commercialization. Their project Waste to Wealth - Swachh Bharat, Unnat Bharat mission, aims to recognize, develop and deploy technologies to treat waste to produce energy, recycle materials, and extract resources of value. The mission also works to identify and provision the development of new technologies that have the potential to create a clean and green environment. The mission leverages science, technology, and innovation to create circular economic models that are financially feasible for waste management.

Last is The Project Monitoring Group (PMG), Invest India is an establishedplatform for the resolution of matters and regulatory tailbacks in projects with investments upward ₹ 500 Cr. in India. The PMG seeks to enlist the unresolved project issues in respect of all mid and large-sized Public, Private, and 'Public-Private Partnership' (PPP) Projects and takes up fast-tracking of approvals, sectoral policy issues, and removal of bottlenecks in expeditious commissioning.

According to Bagla, Invest India has allowed the IPA to fill gaps in showcasing India's opportunity at a global platform.

Perhaps, Invest India group gets its enticement from Bagla. He says his pitch to foreign investors is basic: One, an Indian brought into the world in 2005 will spend \$187,000 in the course of his life. Furthermore, increase that by 1.5 billion. Two, the pace of urbanization, India should make a city the size of Chicago consistently for a considerable length of time. What's more, three: India has approximately 300 million internet users. The first 100 million happened in ten years, the second in three, and the third in eight months. The \$68.55-billion committed by foreign investors shows that the pitch is working.







The Jagdish N. Sheth Best Thesis Award 2020 was conferred on Dr Shreya Mishra, Assistant Professor. The award carries a cash prize of Rs. 50,000 and a Citation was presented to Dr Shreya during the Foundation Day celebrations on 2nd October 2021.

Dr Shreya submitted her Thesis to BIMTECH under the guidance of Dr Manosi Chaudhuri and Dr AK Dey. The Title of her thesis was "Workplace Bullying of Employees in Indian Organizations: A Grounded Theory Approach".

This year 5 scholars, who were awarded their PhD/FPM during July, 2019 and June 2020 were eligible and considered for the award. The award Jury consisted of one senior professor from within the Institute (care was taken to see that no applicant had been under the guidance of this member) and two external members - senior Professors from outside the BIMTECH fraternity who were not only highly reputed but also had recognized research involvement. The Jury carried out a blind review and evaluation of the theses independently on the following five criteria: Importance/ impact of the topic, Originality/creativity of the work, Coverage of the literature and the ability of the scholar to critique, synthesize and bring out key learning points, Critical thinking and application of research tools and techniques and presentation style, structure and language.
