The NACRA Annual Conference is a unique opportunity to engage with other leading case researchers in a smallgroup format, to receive detailed and constructive feedback about your case, and to participate in presentations from experienced case researchers and educators. Our distinctive roundtable track design provides an excellent professional opportunity to enhance your abilities to develop higher quality participant-centered and discussionbased cases, that would be suitable for publication in numerous refereed journals (such as NACRA's *Case Research Journal*), case publishers and distributors, and textbooks.
